GOD CREATED


God, who is perfect, created the whole world and everything in it, including you and me! He created people very special with purpose. God loves everything he created, especially you!

WE SINNED

Anything we do, say, or think that goes against God's rules and the perfect way he created things is called sin. All people, including you and me, have sinned, which separates us from God and deserves the punishment of death.

GOD CREATED

God, who is perfect and holy and eternal, created the whole world and everything in it. He created people special, including you and me. God loves everything he created, especially people, and he made it all very good. God is your creator, and you are his beloved creation for whom He has a plan and purpose!

Words that need to be defined:

Holy, Eternal

WE SINNED

God made everything perfect, but people sinned. Sin is disobeying God's rules, and it separates us from God. All people, including you and me, have sinned. The punishment for sins is death. God is perfect and holy, which means that he had to punish someone for people's sins. But God did not leave us here – he had a rescue plan for our sin problem!

Words that need to be defined:

Sin, Disobeying, Separate, Punishment

GOD PROVIDED

Because he loves us so much, God provided a solution to save us from our sins. He sent his only Son, Jesus, to earth to be punished in our place. Jesus lived a life without sin, and even though he never disobeyed God's rules, Jesus died on the cross. This is something we could never earn or do on our own – Jesus alone can save!

Words that need to be defined:

Provide, Solution

JESUS SAVES

Jesus's death and resurrection provide a way for us to be saved and restore our broken relationship with God. By believing in Jesus and asking God to forgive your sins, God forgives you, and you become a child of God. Do you believe that Jesus saved us? Do you believe that Jesus can be a part of your life? Have you asked him for forgiveness? You just have to ask him to forgive. You can make this decision by asking God at any time.

Words that need to be defined:

Resurrection, Saved, Restores

WE RESPOND

As a child of God, you are invited to learn more about him and grow in faith in God. You are also called to share the Good News about Jesus with the people in your life. You are a light of Jesus to the world around you!

Words that need to be defined:

Faith, Good News

JESUS WILL RETURN

Words that need to be defined:

Rescue, Perfect, Rene,w, Restore, Joy, Peace

ENGAGING QUESTIONS:

How do you treat something special to you?

Have you ever made something so precious and valuable to you? What do you think it means to be created with a purpose? What does it mean to be made perfect?

ENGAGING QUESTIONS:

ENGAGING QUESTIONS:
